Urban Transport Specialist

Key Responsibilities

- Design and execute data collection activities with adherence to timelines and attention to quality of output.
- Develop designs for development of urban transport infrastructure/ systems.
- Technical support to junior team members for preparation of architectural designs and details.
- Preparing and scrutinising cost estimates.
- Lead a team and to work independently.
- Collaborate with other departments, NGOs, research institutes and government bodies at the state level.
- Write technical articles, policy analysis notes, project reports, presentations, other knowledge products and documentation material.
- Travel within the state for site visits and consultations as and when needed.
- Any other responsibilities assigned by reporting officer.

Requirement

- Master's degree in Transportation Engineering / Transportation Planning.
- 10+ years of relevant full-time work experience in planning / designing /implementation of urban transport systems.
- Experience in small/ large scale transport project implementation.
- Should have experience in data collection, conducting research, development of plans, report writing etc. for development of various transport projects.

Engineer – Civil (of the rank of Executive Engineer, PWD)
